



## **MONDIALE Technical English Test**

The Mondiale Technical English Test provides an assessment of a person's foreign language competence across the Council of Europe levels B1, B2 and C1. The overall performance is documented in the form of a language profile providing evidence of a person's individual language skills.

**Test Format:** **Written Test online, Speaking Test by Phone / Skype**

Candidates with a PC and internet access can take the written test at any time.

**Special Areas:** The following specialist areas are on offer in the productive skills (Writing/Speaking):

<b>Civil Engineering</b>	<b>Medical English</b>	
<b>Electrical Engineering</b>	<b>Food Technology</b>	
<b>Mechanical Engineering</b>	<b>Automotive Industry</b>	
<b>Information Technology</b>	<b>Oil and Gas</b>	(further options to follow)

**Levels:** **B1, B2 and C1**

**Structure:** The test has a modular structure, and the following options are available:

- a) General Technical English Module (online) + Writing Test (online)**
- b) General Technical English Module (online) + Speaking Test (Phone / Skype)**
- c) General Technical English Module (online) + Writing Test (online) + Speaking Test (Phone / Skype)**

**Task Types:** **General Technical English Module**

50 Multiple Choice tasks based on vocabulary and structures  
10 Multiple Choice listening comprehension tasks  
10 Multiple Choice reading comprehension tasks

**Writing Test**

Based on a specialist area (cf. above). Candidates chose their specialist area on registration. Two tasks from a list of different types of text.

**Speaking Test**

Based on a specialist area (cf. above). Candidates chose their specialist area on registration. Two tasks (monologue / dialogue) chosen from a list of different spoken language genres.

**Timing:** **General Technical English Module** Online - 60 minutes

**Writing Test** Online - 60 minutes

**Speaking Test** Phone / Skype – 15 minutes

**Results:** **Certificate and Results Sheet** – with details of the candidate's performance in the individual language skills.
