## English-medium Studies

### General Information

- 1) All students must take 180 credit hours of a foreign language before successfully completing their programme of study.
- 2) Foreign language courses are incorporated in the model curriculum of studies for semesters 3, 4 and 5. Students, however, may choose to attend a language course in any semester, from semester 1 onwards.
- 3) International students are required to do a courses in Academic English and at least one other foreign language (e.g Polish)
- 4) Polish students are also required to do a courses in Academic English and at least one other foreign language.
- 6) All students ( both Polish and International) admitted to the Faculty in the academic year 2013/2014 must pass the English exam at C1 Academic level before successfully completing their study programme
