The Foreign Language Centre FLC courses are geared towards English Medium Studies (EMS) students who have not yet used up their granted 60-180-hour ticket. The classes are free of charge.

EMS students can register for the following:

- Language for Specific Purposes courses LSP (Lektoraty Tematyczne LT) in English
ESP courses (English for Specific Purposes):
C1+ level (if you passed your C1 Academic Exam with a grade of **3.0, 3.5 or 4.0**)
or
C2 level (if you passed your C1 Academic Exam with a grade of **4.5 or 5.0**)
- Language for Specific Purposes LSP (Lektoraty Tematyczne LT) – in French, German and Russian at any level
- non-English language courses (general),
- Polish language courses at any level (provided that Polish is not their native tongue),

Extra information about Language for Specific Purposes (LSP) courses

1. **Check whether you fulfill the requirements listed in the language course description. If you want to register for an English language course, you must choose a C1+ or C2 level course.**
Failure to meet the requirements means getting crossed off the list of the students registered for the given course.
2. **In order to register for any course you need to have your C1 Academic Exam passed.**
3. **Regularly check if you are still on the list!** If you have been crossed off the list you will have to register again for a different course.
4. If you want to register for two LSP courses you may **as long as you do NOT register for two English LSP courses during one semester.** We suggest you choose one English LSP course and one non-English LSP course (i.e., German, Russian or French) or alternatively - one English LSP course and a non-English general language course. You will be allowed to take another English LSP course in the next semester.

Paid attendance at LSP courses

1. You can register for a paid attendance course if you are:
 - a WUT student,
 - a WUT employee,
 - a student of another university.
2. The registration for paid attendance LSP courses starts on **October 9, 2017** in room 419 GG. One must register in person.
3. The fee is 12 zł per teaching hour if you are a WUT student – or 15 zł per teaching hour if you are a WUT employee or a student of another university.
4. You can register as long as there are still places available in the given group.
