

WRITING SCIENTIFIC ENGLISH – C1

Środa 16:30 – 18:00

The course is designed to familiarise participants with common forms of scientific writing and the grammar necessary to produce them.

These include:

- 1 – The Amplified Definition
- 2 – The Description of a Mechanism
- 3 – The Description of a Process
- 4 – The Classification
- 5 – The Abstract
- 6 – The Research Article.

Parts 1 – 4 lead up to 5 and 6 – writing an article for publication.

It will also touch upon ways of paraphrasing and describing research results.

Individual work on the university Moodle platform will be required before discussing specific topics in class.

The course allows for some degree of flexibility (each section can be reduced or extended, depending on the participants' needs). It may include a class on preparing a short conference presentation or conference poster. Individual consultations might be included at the end of the course if participants wish so.
