

SPEAKING SKILLS FOR CONFERENCES – C1

The aim of the class will be to allow students to practise their speaking skills useful in the context of conferences. These will include specific presentation skills like repeating key ideas, demonstration, using visuals, thinking about your audience, pace and emphasis, varying your tone of voice or being concise as well as asking questions, responding to questions and comments, paraphrasing and summarising. Participants will also get ample opportunity to practise skills necessary for a round-table discussion: presenting and evaluating arguments and summarising a discussion.

Students will be credited with the course on delivering a presentation on a subject of their own choice to the other participants of the course.
